Ohio Home Care Waiver	An alternative to nursing home care. Assisted Living Waiver	Provides care for Medicaid-eligible adults in an approved assisted living facility. An alternative for people needing more care, but not a nursing home.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Private room/bath • 24-hour on-site response • Meals, Personal Care and Homemaking • Care Management and Social Activities 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 21 or older • Require same level of assistance as PASSPORT • Medicaid- waiver eligible
MyCare Ohio	Provides comprehensive, coordinated services to Medicare and Medicaid eligible adults in designated service areas. (Mahoning, Trumbull, and Columbiana)	An individual selects a managed care organization to oversee health care (CareSource or United Healthcare). Services include medical care, long term care and behavioral health services as well as coordinated care management. DHEO provides in-home waiver coordination.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Age 18 or older • Receives Medicare and Medicaid • Resides in Trumbull, Mahoning or Columbiana.
Specialized Recovery Services	Helps individuals with severe and persistent mental illness, certain diagnosed chronic conditions, or those on the solid organ or soft tissue transplant waiting list.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assistance in developing a specific care plan • Help with finding and keeping a job • Support from others with similar life experiences • Individuals receiving SRS also receive full Medicaid coverage 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 21 years of age or older • Meets diagnosis criteria • Medicaid-waiver eligible
